

YOUR DONATIONS AT WORK: UTILITY ASSISTANCE

Rising costs for gas, childcare, housing, and food have affected everyone in our community, and at the Coweta Community Foundation, we suspected it had hit those affected by the 2021 tornado hardest of all. So as temperatures were rising and energy costs soaring, we created an individual utility assistance program for the families in our Long-Term Recovery case management system. Eligible households were able to apply for a one-time \$500 credit applied to their Newnan Utilities, Coweta-Fayette EMC, or Georgia Power accounts.

We ended up awarding \$36,500 in assistance, and the recipients of these utility credits have been most appreciative. "Thank you SO very much! This is beyond appreciated!" said Rachel. And Kevin said, "Thank you so much! This will be a huge blessing to our family!" We're so grateful to those of you who donate to the Foundation, allowing us to help those who need it most in our community.
